When you give to the Theological Studies by Extension Fund, you bring essential pastoral and ministry training to locations across Africa, equipping leaders without pulling them from their communities.

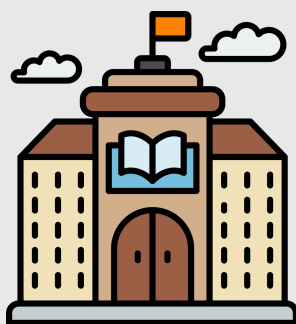


SEMINARY FUND

Campus Development Fund

Support construction, renovation, and furnishings across CABU's properties, creating space for more students and richer learning environments. In 2026, CABU is seeking to acquire three properties adjoining the Kitwe Campus, strategic parcels essential to the physical growth of the ministry.



Deaf Studies Fund

Equip hearing and Deaf leaders with the theological depth and cultural understanding to reach and serve Africa's Deaf community, the most overlooked and unreached people group on the continent.



Imbila Publishers Fund

Strengthen African churches by equipping their leaders with essential Christian literature and theological resources through the publishing and distribution of books to pastors and church leaders.



Library Fund

Provide high-quality theological books for the Paul Kasonga Theological Library at CABU, resources that will serve pastors, students, and faculty for generations to come. The library currently contains nearly 50,000 books and growing.

Legacy Fund

Giving From Your Investment Portfolio

Donating appreciated stock, mutual funds, or bonds held for more than one year is one of the most tax-effective ways to support CABC USA, Inc. Gifts from a growing investment portfolio allow you to give generously without affecting your current cash flow or triggering capital gains tax.

For donors who itemize deductions, a gift of appreciated securities typically increases your total deductions and reduces your income tax. Your charitable deduction is based on the fair market value of the securities on the date the gift is received, not the original purchase price, and may be applied up to 30% of your adjusted gross income.

Giving From Your Donor Advised Fund

Donors who maintain a donor-advised fund may recommend a grant directly to CABC USA, Inc. Please instruct your fund administrator to share your identity with us so that we may properly acknowledge your generosity. For those interested in establishing a donor-advised fund, we welcome the opportunity to assist – it is among the most effective and flexible vehicles available for building a lasting legacy of charitable giving.

Giving From Your IRA Now (QCD)

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a direct transfer of funds from an individual retirement account (IRA) to a qualified nonprofit organization. Because the funds go directly to the charity rather than to the account holder, the distribution is excluded from taxable income – unlike a standard IRA withdrawal, which is taxed as ordinary income.

For donors age 70½ or older, a QCD is often more tax-efficient than taking a distribution, paying income tax on it, and then making a separate charitable gift. It also counts toward the required minimum distribution (RMD) that the IRS mandates beginning at age 74, making it a strategic tool for donors who want to fulfill their RMD obligation while supporting ministry they care about.

Planning Tip: *IRA assets left to children or other heirs are subject to income tax at their highest tax rate upon distribution. Given the tax-deferred nature of a traditional IRA, it may not be the most tax-effective vehicle for transferring wealth to family members or other individuals. Consulting with a qualified tax or estate planning advisor is strongly encouraged.*

STRATEGIES FOR ESTATE PLANNING

Giving Through Your Wills, Trusts, and Tax-Deferred Retirement Accounts

A planned gift to CABC USA, Inc. through your will, trust, 401(k), IRA, or annuity is a powerful way to extend your legacy of generosity far beyond your lifetime, equipping students at CABU for ministry and gospel impact for generations to come. These gifts — known as bequests — allow you to make a significant contribution to the work of the gospel without affecting your current cash flow or available assets.

Through your will, trust, or tax-deferred retirement account, you may designate:

- A specific dollar amount or asset
- A percentage of your estate, the most common approach

For tax-deferred accounts such as a traditional IRA, 401(k), and annuities, a simple beneficiary designation form provided by your plan administrator is all that is required to name CABC USA, Inc. as a contingent, partial, or exclusive beneficiary of your unused balance. Because CABC USA, Inc. is a tax-exempt organization, it receives the full value of any distribution without reduction — unlike individual heirs, who pay income tax on pre-tax retirement assets at their highest tax rate. This designation may also generate estate tax savings.

Your gift may also be structured as a contingent bequest, taking effect only in the event that a spouse or other primary beneficiary predeceases you, providing flexibility while ensuring your charitable intentions are honored.

Giving From Your Life Insurance

One of the simplest and most accessible forms of planned giving is naming CABC USA, Inc. as a beneficiary of an existing life insurance policy. You may designate CABC USA, Inc. as the sole beneficiary or as a contingent beneficiary, ensuring the organization receives the benefit only in the event that a spouse or other primary beneficiary predeceases you. This approach allows you to provide for your loved ones while also honoring your commitment to the gospel work of CABU.

Another option is to donate the old life insurance policy to CABC, USA and receive a tax deduction when you itemize. And a third option is to simply purchase a Life Insurance for the purpose of funding a specific ministry or project when the Lord calls you home. It's common to purchase a \$500,000 insurance policy and make one payment to the insurance company and the policy remains in-force until death. This is a clever way to leverage your financial resources for greater good. Please call Roy Russell for more information and to see if you can qualify.

STRATEGIES FOR SPECIAL ASSETS

Giving Your Real Estate

Your primary residence, vacation home, rental property, land, or commercial and business holdings are all assets that may be donated to CABC USA, Inc., generating significant tax advantages while creating a lasting and meaningful legacy for the gospel work of CABU.

A gift of real estate during your lifetime generates a charitable income tax deduction based on the property's fair market value at the time of transfer. For appreciated property, this approach also allows you to avoid the capital gains tax that would otherwise accompany its sale. Please consult with your tax and estate planning advisor to determine the most advantageous giving strategy based on your specific circumstances.

Giving Now

For appreciated property, a lifetime gift allows you to avoid the capital gains tax that would otherwise accompany its sale, while also generating a charitable income tax deduction based on the property's fair market value at the time of transfer.

Giving Later

You may designate real estate through your will or trust, or transfer ownership now while retaining the right to use and enjoy the property for the remainder of your lifetime. Please consult with your tax and estate planning advisor to determine the most advantageous approach for your specific circumstances.

Gifts of cash, appreciated securities, and real estate may also be structured as a **Charitable Gift Annuity**, providing you with a fixed stream of income for life while supporting the mission of CABC USA, Inc. Please contact our Advancement Team for more information.
